

## 2017 SHOPPING LIST

#101 **\$10 - \$20 Christmas Food for Parma Heights Food Bank.**  
Will help provide special Christmas bags of food beyond the regularly needed supply. Includes Christmas staples such as cranberry sauce, sweet potatoes and stuffing.

#102 **Habitat for Humanity**  
Donations of any amount will support a house build in Cleveland.

#103 **\$10 - \$25 for Minority Education**  
Help continue Presbyterian support for our eight US ethnic schools (Barber-Scotia College, Cook College and Theological School, Knoxville College, Mary Holmes College, Menaul School, Presbyterian Pan American School and Stillman College) providing funds for basic operations and scholarships.

#104 **\$50.00 for Women's Shelters**  
Will provide much needed personal items for mothers and children living in two shelters for battered wives and children. Will provide a contribution toward the cost of the remodeling of Laura's Home, a long-term program facility to homeless women and children. Will be divided equally between Templum House, The Angeline Home and Laura's Home.

#105 **\$10-\$25 for International Friends**  
To provide support toward missionary work for international students at CSU.

#106 **\$25-\$50 Un-designated**  
Your un-designated gifts are welcome and will be allocated by Mission Committee to areas of greatest need.

#107 **\$10-\$100 Dougbe River Presbyterian School in Liberia, West Africa**  
This year's need is for tables and chairs for the new cafeteria so that the kids don't have to sit on the floor to eat.

#108 **\$15-\$25-\$35 Friend to Friend Prison Ministry**  
Help children, 12 years of age and under, in homes whose father is in the Grafton Correctional Institution, by purchasing gift cards for Target. A \$15 gift card could help one child, **or** a \$25 gift card could help two children **or** a \$35 gift card could help three children in a home to celebrate God's love.
