

Effective April 16, 2024 we welcome Rev. Dr. Jon M. Fancher as our new Gap Pastor replacing Rev. Bill Hudson upon his resignation effective April 15th, 2024.

As we have completed most of our transitional work, Parma-South does not require another transitional pastor. Rev. Fancher's key job elements are: Preach at our Worship services; oversee church operations; provide committee support; moderate Session meetings. and most importantly, promote a vision of hope and promise for the congregation in anticipation of the arrival of Parma-South's next called pastor.

Rev. Fancher is Pastor Emeritus of Rocky River Presbyterian Church where he served from 1991 until his retirement in 2022. Jon and his wife Mary were married in 1979 at Parma-South. Mary is the daughter of Rev. Bob Bates, our Associate Pastor from 1968 to 1984. Rev. Jon comes to us with a number of Parma-South connections and we are blessed to have his leadership at this time in our transitional process.
